

## Covenant

I hereby commit with this covenant to seek and serve God in my personal life, and in my workplaces. I make the covenant with God this day as follows:

I will also strive to maintain relationships with others who can help hold me accountable to these commitments. Please God keep me from my fleshly desires that may lead me to violate this covenant.
